

Hands-on Stingray Encounters

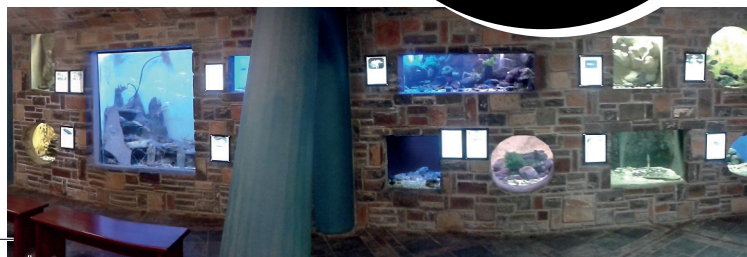
Feel the slippery touch of the Blue Stingray or one of the Eagle Rays and watch up close how they "fly" through the water.



The main display has a capacity of 320,000 liters of water and features a 5 meter tunnel for an awesome under-water experience.

With more than 14 species swimming around, there is an abundance of interesting observations to be made.

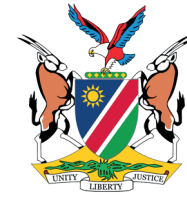
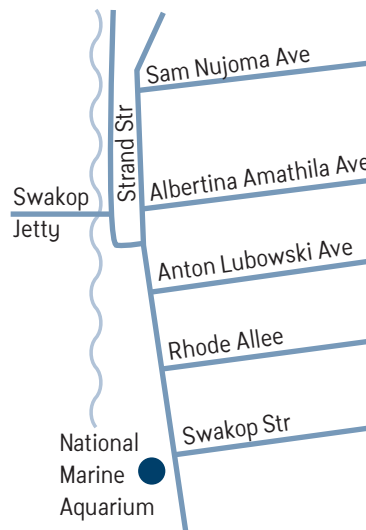
